Anyone interested invited to Jan. 24 meeting



Slagle said the Pony Express 4-H Club, with 15 members, is active at the arena where they practice on Monday evenings from May to September.

The club also hosts a yearly horse show in August. Proceeds from entry fees helps members

pay for the 4-H Foundation's annual trail ride at Halsey forest in October.
