

Swedes first in NP speech event

Beat out Class A schools in debate/speech.

Gothenburg showed who was the best Saturday at a North Platte debate/speech event by a large margin against 29 schools.

Competing against schools as large as Class A Scottsbluff and Norfolk, the Swede speech team accumulated 284 points which was 100 more than Norfolk's 184.

Scottsbluff was third with 140 points.

Speech team adviser Dan Jensen said students competed in the first sweepstakes contest of the season.

"To be eligible for team placing, teams must compete in both debate on Friday and speech on Saturday," Jensen explained.

Twelve Swedes competed in Student Congress Friday. On Saturday, the team began the day 74 points behind Norfolk who was then in first place.

"There was a lot of ground to make up," Jensen said.

However he said everything seemed to fall into place perfectly.

"Our students were at their best and did not get intimidated by the size of the contest or the size of the schools there," Jensen said.
