A full schedule of activities with old favorites and a number of new features are set for the 124th annual Dawson County Fair.

The 2010 fair, with the theme “A Timeless Tradition,” is planned for July 14-18.

With setup beginning on Tuesday, July 13, at 8 a.m. over 50 indoor and outdoor vendors will be setting up their booths and outdoor exhibits. Open class entries can be brought to the Open Class building between 6 and 9 p.m.

On Wednesday, July 14, the excitement begins at 5 p.m. in the grandstands with drill team, flag corps and new this year, a cheerleading competition. The Open Class, Commercial and FFA barn will be open from 6-9 p.m.

Wednesday night will again be Family Night at the carnival. Purchase an armband and ride unlimited rides from 6-11 p.m. Back again this year is the cattle sorting, which will be held in the Steven’s Arena at 7:30.

The car impacts will be intended Thursday, July 15, during the “Crashfest” Demo Derby beginning at 7:30 p.m. at the grandstands. Again this year there will be four-cylinder and full-size classes.

Cross Canadian Ragweed is the featured entertainment this year with a concert on Friday, July 16. It’s a country/rock band that will hit the stage just after Jonathan Singleton, an up-and-coming country artist. The show begins at 7 p.m. with the gate opening up at 6 p.m. at the grandstands. Tickets will be \$25 in advance and \$30 at the gate.
