The Junior and Senior teams will compete again in the west division of the Mid-Nebraska Baseball League. A Senior all-star game is slated for July 1 at Kearney with a league championship scheduled July 8.

Opponents in the league include Broken Bow, Cozad, Holdrege, McCook and Ogallala.

Flesch said the only major changes to the Melon schedule is the addition of Overton back in the mix and the elimination of Ainsworth.

The Melons open the year on the road at Overton on Friday and will host Kearney Tuesday night at 5:30 and 8 p.m.

Games are scheduled with Juniors first, followed by Seniors.

The Junior Area 6 tournament will be in Lexington July 15-20 with the Junior state tourney at O’Neill July 24-28.

The Seniors play in the Area 6 tournament at Holdrege July 22-27 with their state championships set for Schuyler July 31-Aug 4.

In addition to managing the program, Flesch helps coach all teams. Other coaches include Mark Bartels, Brian Bullock, Matt Ostergard and Curtis Ostendorf.
