With 19 hits in 38 at-bats, Mayher finished the year with a .500 batting average to move into the No. 7 spot in that hitting category.

Mayher had 12 singles, five doubles, a triple and one home run that he hit on the home field against McCook.

Mayher also makes the Top 10 at No. 7 in on-base percentage with a .596 average in his 47 times at the plate.

Trent Good was close behind Mayher in number of total hits with 16 earning the team's next highest batting average at .281.
