“Bridgeport had three very strong attackers who could hit the ball wherever they wanted,” Clark said.

The Swedes came back strong-er and a little more stable against Hershey, Clark said, but the ball just wouldn't fall their way.

Gothenburg fell to Hershey 25-19, 25-23.

“That was a game that could have gone either way,” Clark said. “I'd like to get another shot at them. At times we did not play aggressively and I think we could do better against that team.”

In the final game of the day, the Swedes pulled out a 25-11, 25-19 win over Ainsworth.

“We beat Ainsworth like we should beat Ainsworth,” Clark said. “We played for the respect of our team.”

Clark moved Wiggins back to the right side and tried sophomore Makayla Franzen in the middle. It worked out, she said.

“These girls gel like family,” Clark said. “They came back and gave everything they had to play for each other.”

Setters McKenzie Geiken and Kira Peterson deserve some of the credit, the coach said.

“They are working really hard to run a variety of sets that I ask from them,” she said, “and they're doing a good job.”
