Gothenburg's volleyball team remains at No. 7 in the state rankings by the Omaha World-Herald after extending a winning streak to 11 matches with victories over McCook and Lexington on Thursday.

It's an exciting place for the Swedes to be, said coach Mary Clark. Carrying the target is unfamiliar with the girls but the new-found swagger is sure a lot of fun.
