

Swedes hold their own against rated Maxwell team

Each week of the wrestling season, the primary goal of Gothenburg's team members has been to make improvements that will set each individual up for the future, whether that be a district championship this season or a drive toward a state appearance next year.

For some of the more inexperienced wrestlers, the sights are set beyond 2013.
