It's no fluke that the Perkins County girls basketball team has made a trip to the state tournament four years in a row.

"They're good," said Gothenburg coach Tim Peterson, "and they got after us right away."

But it was tenacity in the end that drove the Swedes past the Lady Plainsmen 48-42 Saturday night for Gothenburg's first win of the season.

"I think we had a little more intensity, maybe more of a sense of urgency," Peterson said.

That intensity ebbed and flowed throughout the game but was at a peak when it counted most.

The Swedes started with a solid 6-0 lead before Perkins County got a bucket to fall. Then the Lady Plainsmen went on a 7-0 run of their own and later finished the first quarter leading 11-7.

"Their pressure wasn't affecting us too much," Peterson said of Perkins County's full court defense. "We just weren't finding the right shot."
