

Brady boys still searching for right mix of chemistry

A week into the season, Brady's boys are still trying to find the right combination of players to produce a win.

"I think the ability is there," said Eagle coach Rich Britten, "but we still need to work on the chemistry."

Brady started the season 0-2 over the weekend with a 67-35 loss to a young but salty Paxton team and a 58-51 fall to Cody-Kilgore.

In Paxton on Friday, the Eagles struggled to score in the first quarter, putting only a free throw on the board.

"I think we were a little rusty," Britten said. "Paxton had already played a couple of games."

Brady's defensive effort was solid early, the coach said, but as frustration offensively mounted, the defense followed.

"We just couldn't find much success on offense," Britten said. "I sure thought we would have been better against their man-to-man defense."

As it was, though, the Eagles were just 12-of-44 from the field for 27%.

Senior Corbin Blede was the leading scorer for Brady with 12 points followed closely by junior Kyle Pohlman with 11.

Scoring came around Saturday night once the first-game jitters were gone.

The Eagles came out strong in the first period and out scored Cody-Kilgore 8-5. They stayed close throughout the first half, trailing 21-20 at the break.

“Then we had our usual third quarter let-down,” Britten said. “I think that’s a carry-over from football season and that’s something we’re certainly going to have to address.”

The Eagles fell behind 45-31 at the end of the third period before mounting a comeback effort in the fourth quarter.

Excitement mounted as Brady inched closer with several well-timed three-point shots but the endeavor fell short in the end.

Pohlman finished with 14 points and Christian Arterburn added 11.

The Eagles’ shooting improved to 55% from the field and 67% from the line.
